

# **“I Have...Who Has?” Plants**

---

## **Standards of Learning**

Science 1.1, 1.8, 2.1, 3.1, 4.1, 4.9

English 1.1, 1.2, 2.2, 2.3, 3.1, 3.4, 4.1, 5.1

## **Objective**

Students will:

- Identify important Virginia resources
- Expand oral communication skills and descriptive vocabulary

## **Materials**

- 3x5 index cards
- Marker
- I Have...Who Has? Clues, attached
- Pictures of objects (optional)

## **Background Knowledge**

There are many different ways to describe the things we find in agriculture. This activity encourages your student's creativity and thought about the many Virginia products and animals that we have. Your students are interacting with one another, making friends, and can even work on team building if they are placed in groups. This activity can also be used in various subject areas for a study game or a review of the material that your students have learned. Encourage student to expand this game continuing with the base phrase and including additional Virginia agriculture facts.

## **Procedure**

1. Prepare the “I Have...Who Has?” cards by writing the “I Have...Who Has?” statement on one side and the name of another product used in the game on the other side.
2. Distribute cards to children in class and select a student to start the game.
3. Student should read the “I Have...Who Has?” statement on their card to the class.
4. The student who has the item described by the previous student stands up and reads his/her “I Have...Who Has?” statement.
5. Game proceeds until clues lead back to the student who started the game.

## **Extension**

Use the same concept but change the statements appearing on the cards to fit other subjects. Example: “I have 45. Who has 7x8?” Or “I have the stem, Who has the part of a plant that takes in nutrients from the soil?”
